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## **Stonewall Collegiate's Apprenticeship Option**

### **Are you interested in hiring an apprentice?**

Stonewall Collegiate is offering a High School Apprenticeship Option. This program is designed for students who are interested in pursuing a trade related career. Some of the program highlights are:

- ✓ All students should be 16 years of age
- ✓ HSAP balances senior years schooling with on-the-job training
- ✓ Students must cover the compulsory requirements in Grades 9-12
- ✓ Students will be granted an elective credit for every 110 hours of training
- ✓ Students can be granted up to 8 credits
- ✓ Grades are determined by the school's apprenticeship coordinator after consultation with the student's trainer, using the Apprenticeship Branch competency checklists
- ✓ Hours can be applied to further apprenticeship training
- ✓ Students earn minimum wage + 10%
- ✓ Employers can claim up to \$2000 for an Apprenticeship Tax Credit.
- ✓ Students will have the option to work every afternoon for the year or every day for one semester. (Semester 1 Sept-January, Semester 2 February – June)
- ✓ Students will, hopefully, be available to work during the summer months, holidays, evenings, and weekends if it is mutually agreed upon by both parties
- ✓ Students will take a Safe Workers of Tomorrow Hazard Analysis Practicum
