The SCI staff established the following goals for 2021/2022 and here is what we accomplished:

1. Improving numeracy skills at SCI.

- ◆ Implemented the Thinking Classroom in some of our Math classes and worked with our divisional Numeracy Lead Teacher in our Numeracy Residency.
- ◆ Provided students more time to talk Math in classes and more time to work on solving Math problems.
- ◆ Designated a Numeracy Resource block to support students.
- ◆ Created PLC groups designed to find ways to make Math classes more engaging and implement more critical thinking skills.

2. Improving the well-being of our students and staff.

- ◆ Increased awareness of mental health supports in classrooms and online via Counsellor Corner and classroom visits.
- ◆ Identified the appropriate supports needed for each of our classes and programs.
- ◆ Implemented the beginning of a Zen Den to help with the social-emotional needs of our students.
- ◆ Provided wellness support and opportunities to staff and students throughout the year, especially in the last half of the year.

3. Improving Literacy skills at SCI.

- ◆ Increased the reading resources for students.
- ◆ Provided more opportunities and time for students to silent read in classes.
- ◆ Created PLC groups designed to find ways to increase critical thinking skills in our classes and make lessons more engaging.
- ◆ Provided staff with the opportunity to learn more about the "Thinking Classroom" with Garfield Gini-Newman.
