Here is the latest information on Graduation 2024:

Graduation Fee

- The graduation fee for this year is \$200 for attending the graduation ceremony and the Safe Grad.
- If students just want to attend the graduation ceremony, it will be \$100.
- We will start accepting graduation fees after April 19th, once we have had a chance to let graduates know what fundraising credits they will receive.
