The SCI staff established the following goals for 2017/2018...

1. All members of the SCI community will make stronger connections with each other.

- * We created a yearlong calendar outlining school events.
- * A plan to implement Teacher Advisory Groups was created.
- * Increased staff connections by building collaboration time into all professional development activities.

2. Teachers will provide increased choice geared towards student interests and abilities.

- * Piloted Project Based Learning in Grade 9.
- * Increased student awareness of the High School Apprenticeship, Career Development and Credit For Employment programs. Enrollment numbers for these programs grew dramatically over the year.
- * Investigated flexible program options.
- * Teachers in several subjects increased student choice in project work and assessments.

3. Teachers will identify the literacy and numeracy needs in their class and use strategies to help students improve.

- * Student Services Team prepared an implementation strategy for Classroom Profiles.
- * Teachers attended half day professional development sessions on the FIT teaching model.
